Plan to park along the street, but be mindful not to block driveways.

what to wear

- » Appropriate, comfortable work clothes such as jeans and t-shirts are best; be sure to wear clothes that could get stained.
- » Avoid wearing loose or dangling jewelry.
- » Dress for the weather and varying temps. – layers, rain boots, jackets, etc.
